In the United States, single mothers with children are the fastest growing homeless population. That trend holds true in North Fulton, as well. It's little known that 10% of households in North Fulton live below the poverty line. Many of these households are single mothers with children. With today's economic and housing downturn, the problem has never been greater. The Drake house offers a 90-day emergency residential housing program with a goal toward independent housing. Mothers and their children live in one of our 16 apartments while they work with our social workers to develop an empowerment plan, attend life skills workshops, receive tutoring for the children, and participate in a mentoring program. Success is measured in full-time employment, financial stabilization, improved school performance for children, and independent housing. 75% of the families served by The Drake House have gone on to stable housing.

Since opening our doors to homeless families in 2006, The Drake House has served almost 200 families with over 350 children.
